

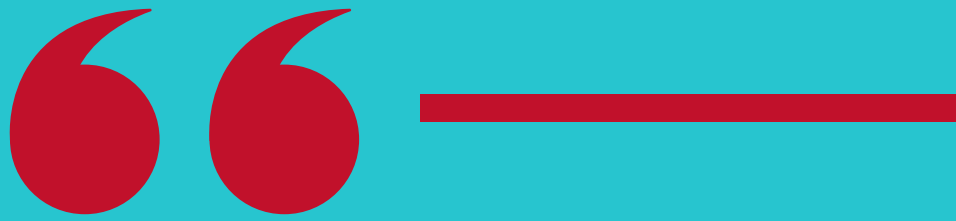
Stop the cuts in development cooperation **now**

After a decade on the rise, bilateral allocable official development assistance (ODA) with gender equality objectives **dropped by 13% from 2023 to 2024.**

At the same time, support to women's rights organizations also fell.

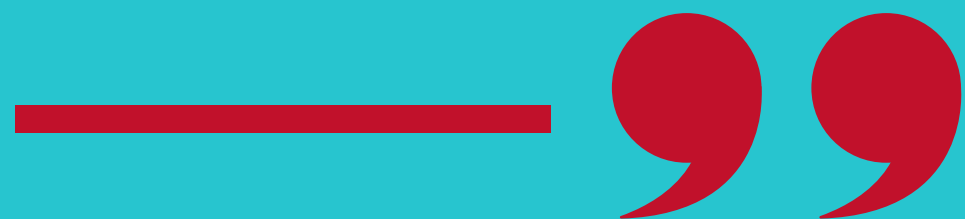
