As public funding declines, philanthropy is playing a growing role in supporting gender justice worldwide.

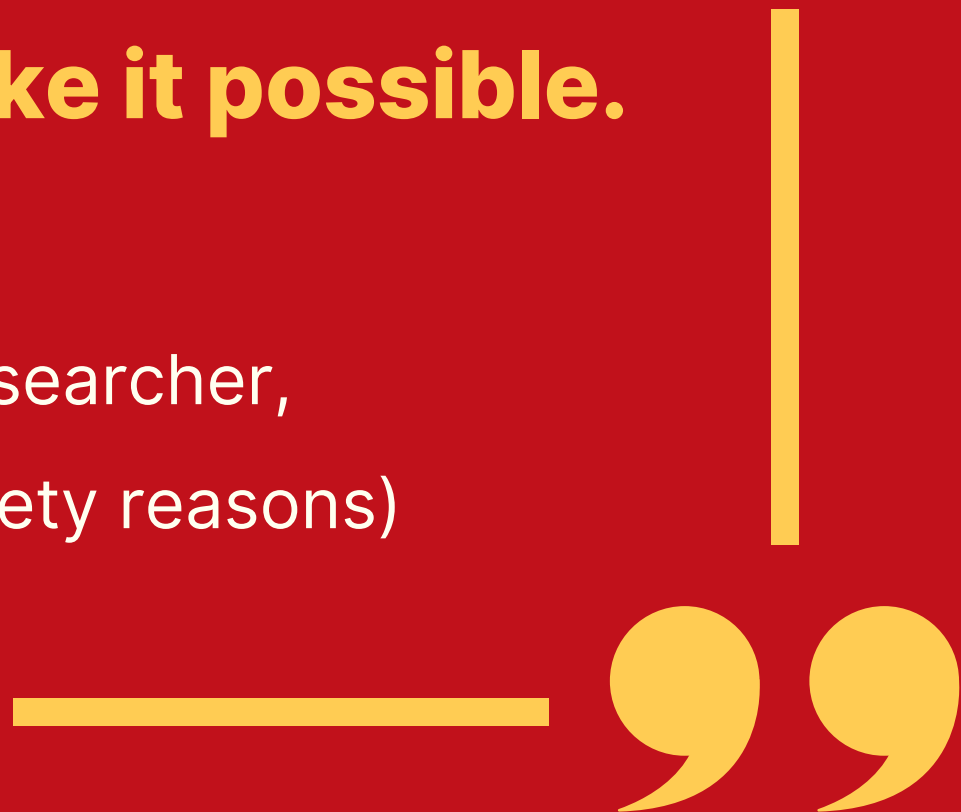
But it is not showing up consistently, and that matters.
